Scarborough South Cliff

The course falls into two parts, divided by the main road from Scarborough to Filey. On the seaward side of the road lie the fourth to tenth holes. On the land-ward side the first three holes and the last eight are laid out along the bottom of the rolling valley stretching southwards into the hills and on the slope of the ridge to the East.

The greatest charm of the course is the glorious situation of the holes on the cliff, looking down to the South Bay and Scarborough Town on the one side and along the bold and rugged coastline towards Filey on the other.

The two parts of the course makes a pleasant contrast and both provide some excellent golf.

The turf, even on the cliffs, is of the down-land rather than the seaside type and provides excellent lies for the fairway wood slots.

The links course is a challenging 18 hole, cliff top par 72 course with fantastic views over Bridlington Bay.

Bridlington Links Golf and Leisure Estate boasts a fine 6719 yard golf course with a distinct "Links Feel" and breathtaking views of Bridlington Bay and the town.

The par 72 course offers spectacular holes along the cliff tops and Danes Dyke and is a challenge to all levels of golfer.

Hornsea golf club was established as a member's club in 1898 and moved to its present site in 1908. The course was designed by Sandy Herd and subsequently modified in its early years by Dr Alister, Mackenzie and James Braid. Further alterations, notably to the 13th hole, were made in the early 1990s.

The club has recently engaged Howard Swan, the internationally renowned golf course architect, to make recommendations on the set-up of the course, as part of our ongoing course improvement plan.

The course is a traditional links design, with the first seven holes running outward towards the iconic water tower. A double loop of five holes, brings the golfer to Hornsea's famous inward stretch, possibly the finest six finishing holes in the country.

The golf course itself is set in a beautiful parkland estate with many native trees, ponds and the trout stream. Water hazards impact on holes seven to eleven, fifteen and sixteen.

The feature hole is the par 5 eleventh, with its three ponds and assorted streams running across and along the fairway which unless accuracy is to the fore, impact at varying stages of the 487 yard hole before you reach the narrow, heavily protected green.

Drifffield Golf Club was founded in 1923, initially being sited on the east side of the town at Meadow Road. A move to the current site on the Sunderlandwick estate took place in 1934. The site was owned by the late Sir Thomas Ferens and provided for an 18 hole, parkland course. During the Second World War the club gave up 9 holes for agriculture in support of the war effort.

It makes good use of the natural landscape, which is further enhanced by several manmade water features and additional mounding.

The 12th is our signature hole. Measuring only 336 yards in length, it is well protected by water and has seen the end to many medal rounds.

Established in 2004, the golf course has just passed its first decade of age and subtle changes along the way have made playing Burstwick a very memorable event. The layout of each hole is coming into its own with continued maturing of tree areas.

The ethos behind Johnathan's design was that every hole offers some kind of risk/reward challenge, with the safe players opting for pars while tempting the more adventurous into taking on dangerous prospects with high potential gain.

Water hazards and bunkers are strategically placed for every shot rewarding course management and experience and those who attempt to overpower may find themselves in bother if they miss their target.

Pike Hills Golf Club, a delightful 18 hole parkland course, situated just off the A64, the course is approx 2 miles south west of the historic city of York, with tree lined fairways it is built around Askham Nature Reserve, an area which has been designated a site of special scientific interest. As you make the short walk from the 6th green to the 7th tee you will suddenly find yourself immersed in a little wilderness - the Yorkshire Wildlife Trusts Askham Nature Reserve.

It is not uncommon to see deer roaming across the course. The course, 6,212 yards, with an SSS of 70 and par 71, has a testing blend of long and short holes which require good course management and careful shot making decisions. A couple of ponds come into play and you are never far away from a dyke which runs round Askham Nature Reserve. When the fairways have been negotiated, some of the trickiest greens in the north of England await. Altogether, it makes Pike Hills a most enjoyable course and a testing game for golfers of all abilities.

Visitors and members always receive a warm welcome at Pike Hills and you will leave after an enjoyable visit with long lasting memories of a great day out
